CGN'S MISSION IN ACTION IN 2023

Calvary Global Network is a family of churches working together to proclaim the Gospel, make disciples, and plant churches.







We fulfill our mission primarily through these four CGN Initiatives. **Expositors Collective, Connect, When She Leads, and Cultivate.**



PROCLAIM THE GOSPEL

<u>Expositors Collective</u>: Raising up the next generation of Gospel proclaimers

The Expositors Collective is a CGN initiative that exists to equip, encourage, and mentor the next generation of Christ-centered preachers. We provide resources through our weekly <u>podcast</u> and our two-day intentional training seminars.

- Held in-person gatherings serving 300+ ministry leaders across the United States
- Created weekly podcast episodes, with over 427,000 total downloads

MAKE DISCIPLES

<u>Connect</u>: Facilitating fruitful relationships among CGN leaders

We flourish when we are connected to God and one another. Connect is a relational initiative that provides coaching, care, and resources for the flourishing of our pastors, leaders, and churches within Calvary Global Network – working together to proclaim the Gospel, make disciples, and plant churches.

- Renamed CGN Care and Coaching initiative to Connect, with a refined vision and path forward, including partnering with Western Seminary's Center for Pastoral Flourishing
- Launched 4 pilot Connect Cohorts designed to facilitate intentional relationships among pastors and leaders to learn from and care for one another
- Created 30 podcast episodes

MAKE DISCIPLES

When She Leads: Equipping women in ministry leadership

When She Leads is an active community created to encourage, equip, and connect women at all levels of ministry leadership through conferences, Zoom gatherings, resources, and an experienced care and coaching team.

- Equipped 1300 leaders through conferences in Nevada,
 Colorado, Ireland, Brazil, and California
- Launched the WSL Care and Coaching Team: Brenda Leavenworth (leadership training), Krista Fox (trauma counseling), Rosemary Cady (passion for the lost), and Kelly Bell (community connector)
- Facilitated monthly Zoom meetings for pastors' wives and ministry leaders
- Experienced over 100,000 downloads of the When She Leads podcast in 2023
- Grew to 18 coaches

In 2024, our team will conduct gatherings in Spain and Portugal and a West Coast gathering featuring Rebecca McLaughlin. Also in 2024, our team will launch a leadership cohort program.



PLANT CHURCHES

<u>Cultivate</u>: Planting Gospel-Centered Churches

Our mission is to help plant Gospel-centered churches as part of the expanding Calvary Global Network (CGN) family. We empower and support local churches to assess, train, and support new church planters and Gospel-centered communities. We believe that the local church is the garden in which the church planters of tomorrow are cultivated.

- Grew to <u>76 coaches</u> and 102 church planters
- Increased to 63 the current number of pledges to plant at least one church in ten years
- Held gatherings in Colorado; Twin Peaks, Temecula, Costa Mesa, and Monterey, California; and the Philippines
- Launched the Cultivate Church Planting podcast in January, with 20+ episodes, 55,519 all-time plays, 2,082 plays per episode, 24,100 YouTube lifetime views, and 247.1 hours of YouTube lifetime watch times




A Tribute To Pastor Chuck, October 2023 -


During that one month, we shared 31 articles from various contributors and had 125,994 article views.

CCBC | Calvary Chapel Bible College


Since 1975, God has used Calvary Chapel Bible







