In-Person Events

In 2024, we hosted multiple Expositors Collective preacher training events in Serbia, California, and Uganda, along with an informal "Pizza 'n' Preaching" gathering, providing additional opportunities for connection and training. In these interactive seminars, attendees learned from experienced practitioners via lectures and participated in small group discussions, fostering deeper learning and facilitating ongoing relationships.

Impact Story: A Testimony from Uganda

A highlight from Mike Neglia about September's Expositors Collective Training Weekend in Uganda:

The conference was a tremendous success, with overwhelmingly positive feedback from the nearly 300 participants. The event was also transformative, equipping pastors and leaders from across Uganda, Kenya, and Tanzania with practical tools for Christ-centered preaching and growing in their walk with Jesus.

One participant shared the following: "My first thinking was that this was going to be like any other Bible-teaching conference. I assumed it was going to be an exposition conference. We came thinking it was going to be a time of sitting and listening to the Word of God being taught the systematic way. But I'm telling you, when we left there, things were different. It wasn't what we expected. What we found once we arrived was that instead of food, they were giving us tools and showing us how to use them, so that we would go and plant the food for ourselves." Another participant expressed deep gratitude, saying, "Praise God for the entire arrangement of the Collective. I was inspired by the teachings, and I was enriched by the practical ways to help me in my preaching the word of God."

This was a truly fruitful and transformative conference that will continue to bear fruit in the lives of the preachers (and their congregations) for years to come.

Cultivate Church Planting

The Next Generation of Calvary Chapel Church Planting

In 2023, Cultivate began a 10-year initiative to plant 1,000 churches in 10 years. In the first year, 15 churches were planted, and over 100 church planters are in the training pipeline.

Planting churches requires financial resources. When you designate your donations to Cultivate, CGN's church planting initiative, 100% of your donations go to church planters. None of those donations are used for CGN general expenses or administrative costs related to Cultivate.


Impact Story: Michael Cardenas - A Calling to Plant


